

POPI ACT PRIVACY POLICY

This privacy policy describes our policies and procedures on the collection, use and disclosure of your information when you use the service and tells you about our privacy rights and how the law protects you. We use your personal data to provide and improve our services. By using our services, you agree to the collection and use of information in accordance with this privacy policy.

1. Interpretation and definition

Interpretation: The following definitions shall have the same meaning regardless of whether they appear in singular or plural.

Definition:

Account: means a unique account created for you to access our services or part of our services

Company: referred to as wither “the company”, “we” “us” or “our” in this agreement refers to ARTsolar, Escom road, new Germany

Cookies: are small file that are placed on your computer, mobile device or any other device by a website, containing the details of your browsing history on that website among its uses.

Country: refers to SA

Personal data: is any information that relates to an identified or identifiable individual.

Service: refers to the website

Service provider: means any natural or legal person who processes the data on behalf of the company. It refers to third-party companies or individuals employed by the company to facilitate the service, to provide the service on behalf of the company, to perform services related to the service or to assist the company in analyzing how the service is used.



Usage data: refers to data collected automatically, either generated by the use of the service or from the service infrastructure itself

Website: refers to ARTsolar, accessible from www.artsolar.net

You: means the individual accessing or using the service, or the company, or other legal entity on behalf of which such individual is accessing or using the service as applicable.

2. Collecting and using your personal data

Types of data collected:

Personal data: whilst using our service, we may ask you to provide us with certain personally identifiable information that can be used to contact or identify you. Personally, identifiable information may include but is not limited to:

- ✓ Email address
- ✓ First name and last name
- ✓ Phone number
- ✓ Address
- ✓ Usage data

Usage data: usage data is collected automatically when using the service. Usage data may include information such as your devices internet protocol address (e.g., Ip address), browser type, browser version, the pages of our service that you visit, the time and date of your visit, the time spent on those pages, unique device identifiers and other diagnostic data. When you access the service by or through a mobile device, we may collect certain information automatically, including but not limited to, the type of mobile device you use, your mobile device unique id, the Ip address of your mobile device, our mobile device operating system, the type of mobile internet browser you use, unique device identifiers and other diagnostic data. may also collect information that your browser sends whenever you visit our service or you access the service by or through your mobile device.

3. Tracking technologies and cookies

We use cookies and similar tracking technologies to track the activity on our service and store certain information. Tracking technologies used are beacon, tags and scripts to collect and track information and to improve and analyze our service. The technologies we may use include:

Cookies or browser cookies: a cookie is a small file placed on your device. you can instruct your browser to refuse all cookies or to indicate when a cookie is being sent. However, If you do not accept cookies, you may not be able to use some parts of our service. Unless you have adjusted your browser setting so that it will refuse cookies, our service may use cookies.

Flash cookies: certain features of our service may use local stored objects (flash cookies) to collect and store information about your preference or your activity on our service. Flash cookies are not managed by the same browser settings as those used for browser cookies.

Web beacons: certain sections of our service and our emails may contain small electronic files known as web beacons (also referred to as clear gifs, pixel tags, and single pixel gifs) that permit the company, for example to count users who have visited those pages or opened an email and for other related website statistics (for example, recording the popularity of certain section and verifying system and server integrity) Cookies can be “persistent” or session cookies. Persistent cookies remain on your

personal computer or device when you go offline, while session cookies are deleted as soon as you close the web browser. We use both sessions and persistent cookies for the purposes set out below:

a) Necessary/essential cookies - administered by us.

Purpose: these cookies are essential to provide you with services available through the website and to enable your use some of its features. They help to authenticate users and prevent fraudulent use of user accounts. Without these cookies, the services that you have asked for cannot be provided and we only use these cookies to provide you with those services.

b) Cookie's policy/acceptance cookies - persistent cookies administered by us.

Purpose: these cookies identify if users have accepted the use of cookies on the website.

c) Functionality cookies- persistent cookies.

Purpose: these cookies allow us to remember choices you make when you use the website, such as remembering your login details or language preference. The purpose of these cookies is to provide you with a more personal experience and to avoid you having to re-enter your preference every time you use the website.

4. Use of your personal data

The company may use personal data for the following purposes:

- a) To provide and maintain our service, including to monitor the usage of our service
- b) To manage your account - to manage your registration as a user of the service. The personal data you provide can give access to different functionalities of the service that are available to you as a registered user
- c) For the performance of a contract- the development, compliance and undertaking of the purchase contract for the products, items or services you have purchased or of any other contract with us or through the service
- d) To contact you - to contact you via telephone calls, SMS, or other equivalent forms of electronic communication such as mobile applications push notifications regarding updates or informative communications related to the functionalities, products or contracted services, including the security updates when necessary or reasonable for their implementation.
- e) To provide you with news, special offers and general information about other goods, services and events which we offer that are similar to those that you have already purchased or enquired about unless you have opted not to receive such information.
- f) To manage your requests- to attend and manage your requests sent to us
- g) For business transfers- we may use your information to evaluate or conduct a merger, divestiture, restructuring, reorganization, dissolution or other sale and transfer of some or all of our assets whether as a going concern or as part of bankruptcy, liquidation, or similar proceeding in which personal data held by us about our service users is among the assets transferred.
- h) For other purposes- we may use your information for other purposes, such as data analysis, identifying usage trends, determining the effectiveness of our promotional campaigns and to evaluate and improve our service, products, services, marketing and your experience.

We may share your personal information in the following situations:

- a) With service providers: we may share your personal information with service providers to monitor and analyze the use of our service to contact you.
- b) For business transfers - we may share or transfer your personal information in connection with, or during negotiations of any merger, sale of company assets, financing or acquisition of all or a portion of our business to another company.
- c) With affiliates - we may share your information with our affiliates in which case we will require those affiliates to honor this privacy policy. Affiliates include our company, any other subsidiaries, joint venture partners or other companies that we may control or are under the control by us.
- d) With business partners - we may share your information with our business partners to offer you certain products services or promotions.
- e) With other users- when you share personal information or otherwise interact in the public areas with other users such information may be viewed by all users and may be publicly distributed outside.
- f) With your consent - we may disclose your personal information for any other purpose with your consent.

5. Retention of your personal data

The company will retain your personal data only for as long as it is necessary for the purposes set out in this privacy policy. We will retain and use your personal data to the extent necessary to comply with our legal obligations (for example if we are required to retain your data to comply with applicable laws), resolve disputes, and enforce our legal agreements and policies. The company will also retain data usage for internal analysis purposes. Usage data is generally retained for a shorter period of time, except when this data is used to strengthen the security or to improve the functionality of our service, or we are legally obligated to retain this data for longer time periods.

6. Transfer of your personal data

Your information, including personal data is processed at the company's operating offices and in any other places where the parties involved in the processing are located. - ✓ under certain circumstances, the company may be required to disclose your personal data if required to do so by law or in response to valid requests by public authorities (e.g., a court or a government agency)

c) Other legal requirements-

- ✓ the company may disclose your personal data in the good faith belief that such action is necessary to: comply with legal obligations, protect and defend rights or property of the company, prevent or investigate possible wrongdoing in connection with the service, protect the personal safety of users of the service or the public, protect against legal liability



1. Security of your personal data

The security of your personal data is important to us but remember no method of transmission over the internet, or method of electronic storage is 100% secure. While we strive to use commercially acceptable means to protect your personal data, we cannot guarantee its absolute security.

2. Children's privacy

our service does not address anyone under the age of 13. We do not knowingly collect personally identifiable information from anyone under the age of 13.
